We arrange and coordinate transfer into the following facilities and services (according to residence-status and language skills)

- detox treatment in the hospital
- substitution treatment at a doctor or medical centre
- psychosocial counseling during a medicaladvised substitution-treatment
- assisted living
- psychotherapeutic services
- self-help groups in different languages
- different addiction therapy facilities



Our services are aimed at people with addiction-related problems in connection with an immigrant-background. We also help and support their relatives.

We also advise and train colleagues and other helpers in the field of refugee-aid.

The people of GUIDANCE are trained on cultural sensitivity and counselling based on individual needs.

With one-on-one-counseling, group-counseling and early intervention courses, we can work in a variety of settings and environments, with and without actual translation.

If desired, our counseling can also be conducted anonymously.

GUIDANCE is affiliated with the DROGENNOTDIENST, a Berlinwide addiction-counseling-center for people of all ages who are at risk of addiction or who already have addiction-related problems. We also support and advise their relatives. Our services are free of charge. We do our counseling regardless of residential status and are subject to confidentiality.

Our services are cut to the individual needs of our clients and can be adjusted at any given time.

Advice and information

We provide counseling with and without an appointment. GUIDANCE will provide a translator if needed. Our services are free of charge and subject to confidentiality under German law (§ 203 StGB).

Group counseling in different languages

Our guided group-counseling-settings are aimed at anyone who is ready for change concerning their addiction. We offer group counseling on a weekly basis with a wide range of addiction-related topics, like the development of change strategies and prevention of relapse, to name a couple. Participation in group counseling is free of charge.
